



Purpose of Edging

 Delineates and defines the shape and form of the overall design

Accentuates garden areas

 Creates a clean, crisp line between beds and other areas In other words: Keeps turfgrass from spreading into surrounding gardens and prevents soil or mulch from spilling onto the lawn











Is the response by plants to mechanical sensation (touch) by altering their growth patterns.




















