MÉRISTÈME est un microcosme fragile servant à la conservation de semences des espèces végétales terrestres menacés ou vulnérables du Québec. C'est un jardin latent, un herbier de semence. Dans sa forme de vaisseau deposé et inachevé, le méristème invite la découverte du patrimoine végétal québécois et appelle à une prise de conscience sur notre héritage botanique. Incorporées à ses parois translucides, les semences sont physiquement présentées aux visiteurs et forment ensemble une structure organique et organisée s'apparentant à la division cellulaire des plantes. Le jardin MÉRISTÈME se compose d'une aggregation de cellules irrégulières dant chaque noyau est la semence d'une espèce végétale menacée. Mises en commun, elles forment un dome immersif qui se dematerialise sous la lumière du soleil et projette l'ombre des semences sur les passants curieux. Le visiteur entre dans l'ensemble moléculaire. Hypnotisé par la logique et la simplicité géométrique réconfortante de la forme, il en prend conscience. Il en fait partie.
