

2020 GROWERS AWARDS OF EXCELLENCE PROGRAM GUIDELINES

JUDGING OF THE ENTRIES - SEPTEMBER 17, 2020

Entries to the Growers Awards of Excellence Program must be delivered to Landscape Ontario I 7856 Fifth Line South Milton, ON L9T 2X8 Sept. 16 - 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and Sept. 17 - 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Deliveries WILL NOT be accepted after 12:00 p.m. on Sept. 17th

AWARD ENTRY GUIDELINES:

- The triplicate skid form must be completed by sub- mitting company and MUST be on skid when delivered (will be mailed to you, if you fax in previous page).
- Landscape Ontario members only, are eligible to enter.

AWARD CATEGORIES:

- 1. Evergreens Field Grown, Upright and Spreading
- 2. Evergreens Container Grown, Upright and Spreading
- 3. Broadleaf Evergreens
- 4. Deciduous Shrubs
- 5. Deciduous Trees 300cm or less
- 6. Deciduous Trees Top Grafted/Worked
- 7. Caliper Trees (Minimum of two specimens)

PLANT MATERIAL:

NOTE: All plant material entered will be auctioned off.

- Plant material must be Ontario-grown at your nursery for at least one year, and must be free of pests and diseases.
- Plant material should be finished and retailready (eg: for sale to a garden centre).
- Ensure the material is the correct size and type for the category entered and there are at least five of each size and type.
- Sizes of plant material should be in metric units.

- There is no entry fee.
- Winners are not eligible to enter the same plant variety in the same category for two years; plants may be re-entered in the third year.
- 8. Vines and Groundcovers
- 9. Perennials
- 10. Unusual and Rare Plants (Worthy of attention, minimum of four specimens)
- Design on a Skid be creative, anything goes (as long as it fits on a skid!)
- 12. Judges Choice Award: The judges will choose the best overall entry to receive this special award
- EACH skid of plant material entered for judging must have a skid form filled out.
- All plant material must be identified by botanical name as well as common name.
- Finished sizes must be noted in metric units and sized according to the Canadian Standards of Nursery Stock (9th Edition) available from Canadian Nursery Landscape Association (CNLA).
- Plant types may be mixed on a pallet as long as there are a minimum of five per type (exceptions are Category 7, two specimens only and Category 10, four specimens only).

JUDGING CRITERIA:

New Introductions: Interesting and exciting but it is the quality of the individual specimens and uniformity of the lot that matters most.

Plant Health: Nutrition and freedom from pests and diseases.

Presentation: Impact of the plant material on the skid - Skids packed full have a very striking appearance.

Quality of Plant Material: Uniformity in growth and habit, colour, lushness and density of growth.

Recent Pruning: For shape is not favourable.

Root Development: Judges do remove the pots and examine the root system. Marks are taken off where root balls fall apart (suggesting overwatering, recent potting or poor management practices).

Tree Guards: Please remove prior to judging. Judges examine the bark.

PRESENTATION OF AWARDS:

- Awards will be given only to those entries worthy of attention as determined by the judges.
- All decisions are final.
- Winners will be announced during the Fall Dinner on Tuesday, November 24, 2020.
- A plaque will be presented to each winner during the Awards Ceremony held at the Fall Dinner on Tuesday, November 24, 2020.
